## What is Helitrox?

Don't you hate that fogged, buzzed feeling you get underwater on your deeper dives? That uncomfortable feeling is Nitrogen Narcosis. Until recently, divers had little choice but to deal with the consequences - until now. Helitrox is a gas mix composed of nitrox with about 15% helium added to the mixture. The result is nothing less than amazing! Just that little bit of helium will reduce narcosis to an almost non-detectable (and non-annoying) level! The result is a safer and more enjoyable dive. ## Open Water Training Opportunities

**Florida, February 20 to 22, 2011** - We've put together a winter trip to Crystal River located on the west coast of Florida to offer open water training opportunities and just to have fun. We will be diving with the manatees plus doing a drift dive in the Rainbow River - both which are a real blast and well within the ability range of even the newest diver to the most experienced. Darryl will be leading this three day trip. We will also be diving in some of Florida's most spectacular and crystal clear springs. All dives will be less than 60 feet deep and are open to all students and experienced divers. The price of the trip includes admission to all dive sites including the "Dive with the Manatees" and the Rainbow River drift dive.

**Dutch Springs PA, June 4 & 5, 2011** - Join us the first weekend of June at Dutch Springs, located in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania for a weekend of diving. Dutch Springs offers divers a diverse variety of diving opportunities ranging from the brand new diver to technical training - plus it's just plain fun to dive there! Underwater attractions include numerous boats and even a helicopter. Numerous underwater platforms located at approximately 20 feet of water offer divers the opportunity to practice skills and other underwater activities without the worry of kicking up silt on the bottom.
